# REGISTER TO VOTE ONLINE

A new secure online voter registration platform is finally here.



### Who can use it?

With the new online voter self-registration platform, all voters – including first-time voters –
can register and amend their registration details at their convenience using computer or any
smart mobile devices.



# Why use it?

 The online voter registration makes voter registration much easier, convenient and right in time, more especially for the younger generations which tend to prefer the use of electronic interaction and modern technology



### When can you use it?

• The online access facility is available 24/7 until the voters' roll closes when the election is proclaimed.



### Who can register to vote?

 To register as a voter, you must be a South African citizen, be at least 16 years old, and have a South African Identity document – either a green barcoded ID book or a smartcard ID or a valid temporary ID certificate.

## How to register online?



- √ Go to registertovote.elections.org.za
- ✓ Enter your name and surname, contact details
- ✓ Capture your address details
- ✓ Upload a photo or file of your valid SA ID green ID book, smart ID or temporary ID, and make sure the barcode is clearly visible
- ✓ Insert the One Time Pin (OTP) sent to you
- ✓ Receive a notification that you are registered to vote within 24 hours.

# How to check if you are registered?



- Go to the IEC website www.elections.org.za and follow the link
- SMS ID number to 32810
- Toll-free phone call from a landline to the call centre (0800 11 8000) only available during election periods
- IEC application on smart phone.
- Voting station during the Voter Registration Weekend.
- Local IEC office from Monday to Friday, during office hours.
